

Meetings of the Board of Education

No. 171
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The Board of Education has a duty to conduct the public's business in an open and fair manner that is known and understood by all. The purpose of this policy is to establish the process that the Board of Education will use for putting items on the agenda of board meetings and meetings of the committees established by the board through bylaws or ad hoc. The Policy will also address the responsibilities and authority for action of board committees.

Meetings of the Board of Education will be held in accordance with the open meeting laws and regulations established by the State of Wisconsin.

A. Regular Meetings

The Board of Education shall conduct a regular meeting at least once each month at a time and place determined by the school board and published in accordance with appropriate open meeting law requirements.

B. Special Meetings

A special school board meeting shall be held upon the written request of any board member. The request shall be filed with the school district clerk or president in the clerk's absence. Notification of said special meeting would be in accordance with appropriate state statutes and appropriate open meeting law requirements.

C. Annual Meeting

The Board of Education shall conduct an annual meeting in accordance with appropriate state statutes.

D. Executive Session

The Board of Education may conduct closed session meetings in accordance with appropriate state statute limitations.
