

## TITLE I

- A. The use of Title I funds will not result in a decrease in the use (for educationally deprived children) of state or local funds which, in the absence of funds under Title I, would be made available for the education of such children and that such children will not otherwise be penalized in the application of State and local funds because of such use of funds under Title I.
- B. Title I funds and property derived therefrom, will at all times be under the control of, and be administered by, a public agency in accordance with the provisions of the Title I regulations.
- C. The applicant agency will render to the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction an annual report and such other reports, in such form and containing such information, including the results of objective measurements of educational achievement and program effectiveness and of research and replication studies, as may be reasonably necessary to enable the State educational agency to perform its duties under Title I. Reports relating to performance shall have been developed in accordance with specific performance criteria related to program objectives.
- D. The comparability of services previously demonstrated with respect to Title I project areas will be maintained in all such areas, including areas serving migratory agricultural workers or migratory fishermen, that will be designed as Title I project areas the next fiscal year.
- E. The assurance of Compliance (HEW441) previously filed with the Office of Education applies to this application.
