The School District of Lodi does not discriminate against a qualified individual with a disability with regard to access to School District events, services, programs, and activities in compliance with Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (Section 504) and Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA). This includes conducting public meetings in places reasonably accessible to the public and providing auxiliary aids and services to the extent necessary to support communications with the School District. A qualified person with a disability is a person with a disability who (a) has a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more major life activities; (b) has a record of such disability; or (c) is regarded as having such a disability. The School District shall determine and provide an aid, benefit, or service to a qualified person with a disability in order to accommodate such person.

The District Administrator/or his or her designee is the Section 504/ADA Coordinator and shall be responsible for processing all reasonable requests for modifications to accommodate qualified persons with disabilities for participation in school district related services, programs, or activities.
