

Animals in the School

The school buildings, parking lots and athletic facilities of the School District of Lodi are expressly limited for the use of students, employees, community groups, rental groups and visitors at all times. No mammals, fowl, reptiles, amphibians, fish, pets or exotic pets are allowed on school premises unless the animal or pet has been administratively approved as part of a classroom curriculum or building program (i.e. pet day, VIP Day, birthday, etc.) or are canine assistance for hearing, sight or physically impaired individuals.

This restriction applies to all activities held on school grounds or in school buildings except as noted.

Any group requesting use of school facilities will be provided with copies of this policy as part of the facility use request.

Exceptions: Individuals accessing the Ice Age Trail, from district parking areas, may escort their pet, providing it is restrained by leash or other normal means, to the Ice Age Trail across the school property. Likewise, individuals walking the trail with their pet may cross school property as long as they remain on the trail with their pet.
