

Full-Time Student Status

A student shall be considered a full-time student in the Lodi Schools according to the following minimum standards:

- I. Elementary and Middle School - full day course of study.
- II. High School - must be enrolled in the following minimum number of courses.
 - 9th grade - six credits
 - 10th grade - six credits
 - 11th grade - five and one-half credits
 - 12th grade - five credits

EXCEPTIONS:

- I. EEN students may carry reduced schedules prescribed by the Individualized Educational Program.
- II. At Risk students may carry reduced schedules as recommended by the high school counselor, high school principal and agreed upon by student and parent.
- III. If a student is involved in a school sponsored and supervised work experience program, the equivalent credit earned toward the fulfillment of a minimum program will be identified.
- IV. All senior high school students must attend class or study hall each of the eight periods of the school day except under the following circumstances:
 - A. A student who has completed four years of high school and who is returning to complete credits toward graduation will be required to be in school only during the hours those classes meet.
 - B. A student/parent with child care responsibilities may be released from study halls.
 - C. A student as referred to in Exceptions I, II, and III of this policy.
