SCHOOL ADMISSIONS

No. 420 (A) 5-5-86 (R) 1-6-92 (R) 1-11-93 (R) 3-9-15

The Board directs the district administrator to establish guidelines and procedures for admitting students to the School District of Lodi. These guidelines and procedures shall include, but not be limited to:

- 1. Age requirements for regular admission to kindergarten and first grade
- 2. Screening procedures for students entering kindergarten
- 3. Criteria for early admission to kindergarten and first grade
- 4. Criteria for admission to EEN preschool programs
- 5. Procedures and criteria for determining grade placement at all levels for transfer and home-based students
- 6. Procedures for documenting compliance with immunization regulations

All procedures shall be in compliance with state and federal rules, and board policies pertaining to nondiscrimination. In addition, all admission procedures and guidelines shall be printed and made available to staff and the public.

The School District shall not discriminate in admissions to any school, class, program or activity on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, cognitive, emotional or learning disability or handicap.
