

Admission of Nonresident Students (Other than Open Enrollment Students)

The Lodi School Board will allow a student who has gained 12th grade status and is a resident of the district at the time of gaining such status to complete 12th grade without payment of tuition even if the student is no longer a resident of the district.

Any student who is enrolled and a district resident on the third Friday in September or on the second Friday in January of the current school year and who has been enrolled in the School District of Lodi for a least 20 school days during the current school year will be allowed to complete the school year in the School District of Lodi without payment of tuition, even though the student is no longer a resident of the district.

Any student who meets all of the following criteria will also be allowed to attend the School District of Lodi without paying tuition:

1. The student was a resident of the school district on the second Friday in January of the previous school year;
2. The student was enrolled in the school district continuously from the second Friday of the previous school year to the end of the school term of the previous school year;
3. The student ceased to be a resident of the school district after the first Monday in February of the previous school year; and
4. The student continues to be a Wisconsin resident.
