In the State of Wisconsin, persons 18 years of age and older are afforded the rights and responsibilities of adults. However, rules and regulations adopted by the school board and administration are binding upon all students attending school regardless of their age. In the case of students over the age of 18, all communication, verbal or written, shall be directed to the student. Parents or guardians of students over 18 years of age shall be provided copies of all written communications.

Students 18 years of age and older who write their own excuses for absence will be referred to the principal or his designee to determine if an excused or unexcused pass is to be issued.
