Locker Room Privacy

The Board of Education seeks to protect the right to privacy in locker rooms, restrooms, and changing areas. The district limits access to district locker room facilities and changing areas. Further, the board prohibits any type of photography in areas where one would have a reasonable expectation of privacy, such as locker rooms, restrooms or changing areas.

Access to locker rooms and changing areas, while in use, is limited to participating athletes or performers, their coaches, emergency responders, and other designated district employees with student supervision responsibilities.

The use of any device capable of photography or the transfer of video images, such as video cameras, web-cams, surveillance cameras and cell phones is strictly prohibited in district locker rooms, restrooms, and changing areas. The district will not use surveillance cameras in areas where one would have a reasonable expectation of privacy.

The board also prohibits sharing, distributing or publishing on the Internet any image obtained in violation of expected privacy in locker rooms, restrooms, or changing areas.

Anyone found to be violating another person's privacy through the use of photographic devices or in the sharing, distribution, or publishing of images obtained in district locker rooms, restrooms, or changing areas, is subject to discipline and referral for criminal prosecution.

The district administrator or designee will be responsible to develop procedures to ensure that this policy is noticed and enforced.
