IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO KNOW & BUS TRANSPORTATION

SCHOOL ARRIVAL TIME: Summer School runs Monday through Thursday. Students can begin arriving at 7:50 am. Students should wait in the Commons area until they are told they can go to classrooms (at 7:55). Classes begin at 8:00 am - **Students need to be in their classrooms at that time.**

ENROLLMENT: Though summer school is not required, we do ask that if you are enrolling your child, they do plan to attend. We have limited space and often students cannot take the class because it is full! The State aid we receive is also based on attendance!

LOW CLASS FEES: In order for Lodi School District to receive state aid, the district is only allowed to charge for supplies used for the class. Lodi School District then must submit attendance information to receive our payment from the state. State Aid is based on attendance! Out of District residents should contact the school about out of district fees.

WHAT TO BRING ALONG: Be sure you send your child/ren schedule(s) along with them on the first day and for the correct session! The Schedules will show where their classes are located and will help staff direct students to the correct rooms. Parents are welcome to come to school and help kids find classrooms too! Classes will be held at the High School again this year! Back packs are optional and no other items are required unless indicated in the description of the class.

MEDICAL NEEDS: Any inhalers or epi-pens should be brought to Summer School during the Open House or the 1st Day of Summer School. Please be sure to label with students name and grade!

BUS INFORMATION: During summer school we will use colors to determine the bus they will ride, please make sure your child knows which color bus they should ride home. The bus color and time for pick up and drop off will be available early June. Please watch for a registration notification with this information and also check the summer school website! Registration for bus transportation is **REQUIRED** by Summer School Deadlines. Registration is done through Summer School using either the on-line registration or paper registration.

GRADE LEVEL REQUIREMENTS: Students can enroll in classes that indicate your child's CURRENT grade level during the 2016-17 school year. Students entering 4K in the fall are categorized as P4K

REFUND/CANCELLATIONS: Fees are non-refundable unless the Summer School Campus Program cancels a class.

Saunters Hiking – Grades 3-11

June 12 – June 16 (June 16th is a half day)

The Saunters program started in Lodi in 2008 with a weeklong course dedicated to hiking. Celebrating this 10th year of Sauntering in Lodi requires some dynamic hikes. Students will load the bus each day at 8 am, travel to a unique segment of the Ice Age Trail, return to school by 4 pm. Along the way participants in grades 3-11 will explore Wisconsin on foot, build leadership skills and learn about our glacial legacy through the ColdCache program. ColdCache is similar to geocoaching only students identify landforms to meet the goal.

Afternoon Course Opportunities

Class Name: Code Academy!	COST: \$0
<i>This course is designed for students to learn the basics of coding. Students will gain an understanding of what programming is, how to create, test, and build upon their own programs, and see how they can use coding to help them in everyday life!</i>	
Class Name: Dr. Seuss Science!	COST: \$10
<i>Every day will be filled with a new and fun Dr. Seuss related science experiment!</i>	
Class Name: Everything You Ever Needed to Know	COST: \$10
<i>Everything you needed to know would cover much of the same information but would delve deeper into Health, Mental Health, Safety, First Aide and Basic Survival. We will explore movies dealing with Social Conflicts of who we are and being honest with yourself.</i>	
Class Name: Junior Lifeguarding	COST: \$10
<i>American Red Cross Junior Lifeguarding is designed to guide youth to the American Red Cross Lifeguarding course by building a foundation of knowledge, attitudes and skills for future lifeguards. Participants are not required to master or perfectly execute skills; they should learn techniques and build stamina during this program. (This course does NOT certify participants in first aid, CPR-AED or as a lifeguard) Junior Lifeguarding is an effective transition from upper-level Learn-to-Swim courses to the American Red Cross Lifeguarding program, challenging participants to stay involved with aquatics. Junior Lifeguarding will introduce participants to: The skills needed for entry to the American Red Cross Lifeguarding course Communication and decision-making skills The basic responsibilities of a lifeguard The basic knowledge and skills required to be a lifeguard Before entering Junior Lifeguarding, participants must demonstrate the following skills: Swim front crawl for 25 yards continuously while breathing to the front or side Swim the breaststroke for 25 yards using a pull, breathe, kick and glide sequence Tread water for 1 minute using arms and legs Show a level of comfort on the back by floating on the back for 30 seconds or swimming on the back for 25 yards using the elementary backstroke or back crawl Submerge and swim a distance of 10 feet under water</i>	
Class Name: Karate!	COST: \$10
<i>This introductory karate class will focus not only on physical karate skills, but also on the important skills that will lead to personal success in life. Students will learn to focus, pay attention, be respectful, and become part of a team all while having fun!</i>
