



2015-2016 *Accolades & Awards*

Academic:

- Consistently scores above State and National average for ACT
- Highest in Capitol Conference for ACT scores
- Second highest in CESA #5 for ACT scores
- 37% of our student body took at least one AP class for 2015-16
- Students passed 113 out of 168 AP exams taken for a 67.7% pass rate (state average is 67.9%)
- 31 freshmen passed an AP exam last year
- In 3 years 270 AP exams passed (typically each exam is worth 3 credits @ \$347 per credit at UW – Madison – Estimate savings to students/parents: \$281,070)
- Lodi has 15 AP Scholars

- Named to the 4th, 5th and 6th AP Honor Roll

- 7th/8th grade Math Team finished 1st in region and competed at the State level.
