

Student Alcohol and Other Drug Use

No. 443.4

(A) 3-9-15

- A. The manufacture, distribution, dispensation, possession, use of or presence under the influence of alcohol, inhalants, controlled substances or substances represented to be such, synthetic drugs or unauthorized prescription medication is prohibited on school premises or at school activities.
 - 1. Students who violate this policy will be subject to disciplinary action up to and including suspension and/or expulsion from school.
 - 2. Information regarding disciplinary codes shall be printed in appropriate handbooks and made available to students, employees and the public.
- B. Students may possess prescription/non-prescription medication (inhaler, EPI pen or medication) for self-administer only if a signed Medication Request/Consent form is on file with the appropriate building administrator, his or her designee, and the district/school nurses).
- C. Only the district/school nurse or nurse trained school personnel may administer a prescription/non-prescription medication to student if a signed medication requires/consent form on file with the appropriate building administrator, his or her designee and district/school nurse. The medication shall be supplied by the pupil's parent or guardian, the medication shall be supplied in the original manufacturer's or prescription package and the package must list the ingredients and recommended therapeutic dose in a legible format.
