Weapons on School Property

No. 832 (A) 6-12-95 (R) 11-13-95 (R) 9-14-98

No person shall possess a weapon, as defined in 18 U.S.C. '921, on school property, school bus or at any school-related event. (A weapon is defined as any object that by its design and/or use can cause bodily injury or property damage.) In addition, no one may use any article to threaten or injure another person.

Exceptions to the district prohibition of possessing a weapon on school property includes the following:

A weapons as defined in this policy will include:

- a. any weapon which will or is designed to or may readily be converted to expel a projectile by the action of an explosive
- b. the frame or receiver of any weapon described above
- c. any firearm muffler or firearm silencer
- d. any explosive, incendiary, or poison gas
 - (1) bomb
 - (2) grenade
 - (3) rocket having a propellant charge of more than four ounces
 - (4) missile having an explosive or incendiary charge of more than one quarter ounce
 - (5) mine, or
 - (6) similar device
- e. any combination of parts either designed or intended for use in converting any device into any destructive device described in the two immediately preceding examples, and from which a destructive device may be readily assembled
- f. knives or any sharp object used to threaten or cause bodily injury
- g. AMMUNITION SHALL NOT BE BROUGHT TO SCHOOL OR SCHOOL PROPERTY.

Any person violating the policy on possession of weapons and/or ammunition may be subject to criminal prosecution.
