Bring a Friend or family member with you! Together you can work on your own project and have some relaxing time together to chat and laugh and complete a project! Students new or newer to crochet will need someone along to help them and learn as well, so crocheting at home will be easier when someone knows how to assist! Feel free to also make your own project along with them!

Tentative Schedule and how this class will work!

Your project is your choice: a Scarf or a blanket

A scarf of course is not as big, but once you get stitching a blanket can be done quickly as well!

You will need to work at home to complete this project by the end of the scheduled class time. Goal approx. 7.5" a week (to get a 60" blanket, so give or take depending on your project size) (this will depend on the type of yarn you choose as well).

Prior to Class: Pick out your yarn and get the correct hook (based on yarn choice) Information will be emailed to you about this once you are registered and how much yarn you will need to complete the project.

Class #1: October 13 20 5:00-6:30 pm Getting Started. Start project and get the basics of the project

Class #2: October 27. 4:30-5:30 PM

Come if you need assistance or want work time without home interruptions!

Class #3: November 10. 4:30-6:30 pm

Again come if you need assistance or just want to hang out and have work time without any home interruptions! Come anytime and stay for however long you want/can

Class #4: November 17. 4:30-5:30 PM

You know the drill! Any length of time between

Class #5: December 1. Anytime between 4:00-5:30 pm

CRUNCH time! Your blanket should be getting pretty close to being the finished length! Remember we need to add the border yet!

Class #6: December 8: 4:30-6:30 pm Finish up blanket and begin border

Class #7: Last class: December 15: 4:00-5:30 pm

Finish border and enjoy your project!
