Free COVID Testing Site Transitions to a new process on November 8.

Location: On the east side of the High School building at the Door V entrance. This is located between the stadium and the pool entrance.

What kind of test? The tests are PCR tests that are collected from an anterior nasal sample, which is not painful, but feels more like a tickle in the nose.



Who can be tested? Students, staff, and their immediate family members who are symptomatic or who are considered close contacts can be tested.

When: Testing will be available from 9AM-12PM Monday - Friday. No appointment needed. The first time you visit the site <u>after November 8th</u> you will need to follow the registration at <u>Lifepoint link- COVID testing NOAH labs</u>. Please register before arriving at the site. Each person testing will need a separate username and password, but all results can be sent to the same email. Once you are registered you will not need to register again, just give your name and birthday at the testing site. If you are needing help with this process there are further directions on the school district website. If you have questions please call Jean Winter at (608)438-3100.

Where do we park? There is parking located along the side of the building so that families can walk up to the covered entry. Please remain outside.

Steps to obtaining a COVID test for the first time only:

- 1) Follow link to <u>www.lifepointlink.com/noah/outreach</u>
- Follow Step one if this is your first time registering to sign up, otherwise you will use your login here.
 *You will only need to register and consent for testing once, it will not need to be completed each time testing is done..



- Can I register multiple children with one email address? Yes, the system will allow multiple registrations with the same email address, but you must create a separate username for each child.
- Why am I getting an error message when trying to register after being manually entered by my school or if my test was submitted on a paper requisition form? To connect your specimen to your patient registration, you must wait for results to be finalized within the portal. If you try to register before results are finalized, there will not be an order to link to. Please allow 24-48 hours to register in this situation.
- What are typical turnaround times (TAT)? Currently, we are trending a 24-36 hour TAT from receipt of samples at the lab. Occasionally, situations arise that may delay a sample, but we will do our best to obtain missing information and result as soon as possible. We understand that every sample is a person and timeliness is extremely important.
- How will I see my results? If you have pre-registered, you will receive an email
 notification that your results are ready, instructing you to log into the patient portal. If
 you have been manually entered by your school or your test was submitted on a paper
 requisition form, please allow 24-48 hours for results to be finalized and register with the
 attached registration process.
