

AT HOME...BEFORE SCHOOL

- Every morning, we need every student and staff to complete the daily health screener.
 - This google form will be emailed to you by 5:00 am.
 - It is checked each day by office staff.
 - If you do not complete this form, a staff member will be checking in with your child and contacting the family directly.
- Please make sure to bring your ipad (fully charged) and your backpack with your folders or binder from your teacher. This will be coming back and forth every day.
- We will offer breakfast or lunch, or your child can bring something to eat.



Students:


- **All students will have a tag with their name, teacher, and after school plans to ensure they get to the correct spot safely.**
- **Before school:** 4K students will go directly into the building through Entrance K.
- **Before school:** Students riding the bus will go through entrance K. Students getting dropped off will go through the main doors.

Drop off & Pick Up:
For everyone's safety we ask parents to stay in cars . We also ask that parents do not walk students into the building. If they need to talk to a staff member, they need to email or call the school.

If your child is getting picked up after school, please have a sign in the window with your child's name and grade. Staff will be looking at this to help get your child to your car.

STUDENTS RIDING THE BUS


- Staff will start supervision at 7:45 am
- If your child is riding the bus, they will be dropped off in the bus loop by the yellow “Bus Drop Off/Pick Up” sign.
- Students will all be wearing a mask, try to maintain social distance from others, and walk in a single file line to the playground blacktop if they are in grades K-2.

STUDENTS WALKING

- Staff will start supervision at 7:45 am.
- If your child is walking to school, they will walk on the sidewalk to the left of the parking lot and meet a staff member. Then they will walk directly into the building through the main doors.
- We will have a staff member helping students walking at the crosswalk at Ridgestone & Sauk as well as Sauk & Dale



STUDENTS DROPPED OFF

- If your child is getting dropped off, please use the parent loop and pull forward to the red “Car Drop Off/Pick Up” sign.
- PLEASE wait until an adult signals for your child to get out.
- All students will have a backpack tag that will help us identify your child’s name, teacher, grade, and after school plans. **Please have this on their backpack for the first day.**

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

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Dismissal



Students:

- **All students will have a tag with their name, teacher, and after school plans to ensure they get to the correct spot safely.**
- **After school:** 4k students will wait outside of the front of the school in a bus or pick up line.
- **After school:** students getting picked up will walk through the building to the playground and wait for their ride. Students riding the bus will wait until their bus arrives and then exit the building through entrance K.

Drop off & Pick Up:

For everyone's safety we ask parents to stay in cars. We also ask that parents do not walk students into the building. If they need to talk to a staff member, they need to email or call the school.

If your child is getting picked up after school, please have a sign in the window with your child's name and grade. Staff will be looking at this to help get your child to your car.

3:00 PM - END OF SCHOOL


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Classroom teachers will walk students out to the playground blacktop.

- 4k Students will be waiting outside the main doors.
- Students getting pick up will stand on a colored marking on the blacktop to ensure they are 3-6 feet away from other students.
- Students riding the bus will wait in the classroom and then walk out to the bus, with adult supervision, when the bus arrives
- Safety is our #1 concern - we will try to get students dismissed as quickly as we can, but thank you for your patience.

STUDENTS RIDING THE BUS

- If your child is riding the bus, they will be walked by a staff member to the bus loop by the yellow “Bus Drop Off/Pick Up” sign.
- Students will all be wearing a mask, try to maintain social distance from others, and walk in a single file line.

STUDENTS WALKING

- If your child is walking home, a staff member will lead them as they walk on the sidewalk to the right of the parking lot out of the school zone.
- If you walk your child, please make sure to be waiting by the “walker” area, wearing a mask, and keeping 6 feet distance from others.
- We will have a staff member helping students walking from the Primary to the High School and Middle School



STUDENTS PICKED UP

- If your child is picked up, please make sure you have a sign in your window with your child's name and grade. (THIS WILL BE IN YOUR SUPPLY PICK UP BAG ON JANUARY 13).
- As you pull through the loop, a staff member will read the name(s) of students you are picking up. They will use a walkie to radio the staff on the playground of which students are ready to be picked up.
 - Another staff member will help your child get to your car.
- Pull forward to the yellow "Car Drop Off/Pick Up" sign.
- **Please** wait until an adult signals your child to get into the car.

FOOD SERVICE - 4K
