Dear Parents and Guardians.

This communication is intended to update you on the following issues:

- 1) Fall Start and Instruction Questions: The one clear and consistent understanding regarding schools opening is that school buildings and facilities are to remain closed through June 30, 2020, except for use by school-based daycare centers. At present there are no clear or consistent answers to what school will look like in September. We are working on plans to accommodate multiple instruction delivery models that may be recommended or required when school opens in the fall. Depending on pending county and state directives we are hoping to try some of these optional models during our July and August Summer School program. We will continue to communicate and inform students, parents, and staff as local, county, and state agencies provide guidance and answers to the health and safety issues that will guide our planning for the start of the 2020/2021 school year.
- 2) Materials Pickup and Drop Off Process: A plan is being finalized and will be communicated to students and parents next week regarding how chromebooks and I-pads will be collected for summer maintenance and repair. Information will also be provided regarding how personal possessions left in lockers, cubbies, and/or classrooms can be picked up from your students' respective school building. Please watch for this communication on Tuesday, May 26th.
- 3) Online/Virtual Learning Input Staff Training: Survey input from students, parents/guardians, and staff have been an invaluable asset in determining what staff development we will be engaged with during the week of June 1st to 5th to help improve online learning. Thank you for sharing your thoughts and helping our staff improve our instruction and the process for online learning.
